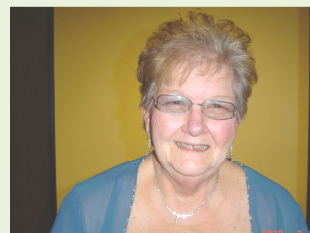

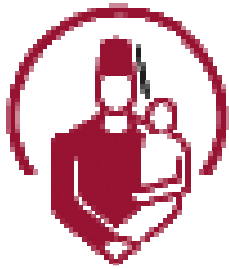

Shriners Hospitals for Children™

We were honored at the Installation of 2014 Isis Temple Officers to have the President of the Hadi Shrine Hospital Staff speak. To keep you informed we have asked President, Ron Higgs to share his speech with you!

Today, I would like to take a few moments and talk about our participation with our hospitals and how we adapt to the various changes taking place now and in the future. Due to the economic downturn, Tampa requested all 22 hospitals to reduce their costs by 50%. We have 4 hospitals within our jurisdiction. They are Lexington, Cincinnati, Chicago and St Louis. Lexington, which is 2nd only to Tampa as the busiest hospital, will close their hospital and move to the University of Kentucky Campus and combine their facilities with ours.

Cincinnati will not close, however they will start accepting Clef Lip and Palate Patients as well as current burn patients. By increasing patient flow the hope is to increase Revenue by 50%. This hospital will remain a full hospital.

Chicago had already started cutting expenses by out sourcing such items as braces and casts. St Louis will close the 160,000 sq. ft. hospital and is in the process of relocating and building a new 55,000 sq. ft., 3 story hospital. The hospital will be very close to the children's hospital complex. There will be 12 semi-private rooms that will be located on the 2nd floor. Emphasis will be for outpatient services. The estimated savings for the change is expected to be approx. 55% from a cost of 24 Million. They are presently experiencing to approx. 11.5 Million. Unfortunately the fall-out will be the elimination of 74 employees. Tampa has stated we are not to use the term "free" or no cost when referring to the treatment of our patients. The proper phrase is "we treat all children regardless of their ability to pay". This came about when we started billing 3rd parties such as Insurance Companies for those patients whom carried insurance. This has been a valuable asset of reducing cost.

Our present budget of nearly \$850 million a year was reduced last year by approx. \$410 million dollars by 3rd party pay reimbursement. For those patients who do not carry insurance, by law we must bill for services, however this occurs only once. Our hospitals are not in the collection business and do not handle money.

All return visits are considered "new" and outstanding bills are not available or considered to the hospital performing patient services. We are considering adding the "Wounded Soldier" to our patient services list.

These are Soldiers who have lost limbs or who have had severe burns from combat related losses. This would require raising our age limit from 18 yrs. to 26 yrs. old. As you can see there are a lot of changes that are taking place and many more yet to evolve.
