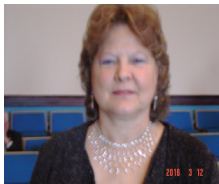

Spring is a new beginning. The grass comes alive and the flowers start to bloom. Isis Temple has the officers' installation. The installation is so appropriate for this time of the year.

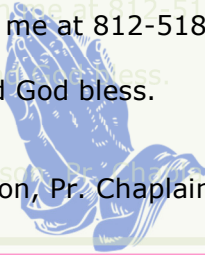

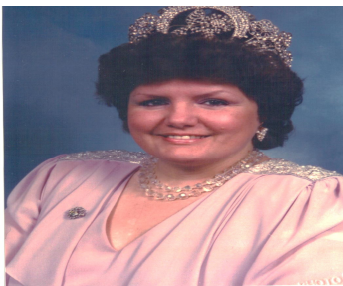

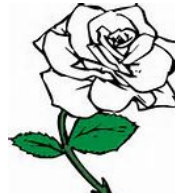
