

Making a Difference

Making a difference – That's what it means to be part of Daughters of the Nile. This year we should be very proud of the opportunity to make a notable difference to the lives of the patients at the St. Louis Hospital.

In September, we were contacted by Noble John Nelson who serves on the Board of Governors for the St. Louis Hospital regarding a special funding campaign to raise money for a new EOS Scanner. This scanner provides life-size pictures of the patient's full skeleton. It allows the doctors to view 3-D models of the patient's posture and joint orientation from any position that is comfortable for the patient (standing or sitting).

The estimated cost of this scanner will be in the amount of \$885,000.00. The hospital is not allowed to use their annual budget money for new radiation technology. Because of this regulation, the funding had to be sought elsewhere.

This is where we come in. We were approached with an opportunity to be part of this fundraising campaign to bring this life-changing technology to the kids. Our by-laws state we can only send donations to the Daughters of the Nile Foundation, but the Foundation has recognized many members desire to assist the Shriners in the special funding projects of the hospitals. The Foundation allows us to make a donation through them earmarked for a special project and forwarded to the designated hospital.

Our temple began discussions regarding our annual donation and the membership's feelings on earmarking this year's donation for the St. Louis EOS Scanner. The suggestion was met with enthusiasm. At the November 6, 2017 Stated Session our membership voted to earmark a total donation from our Temple in the amount of \$5,500.00. Way to go, ladies! Just imagine the cutting edge care "our kids" will receive from this wonderful piece of medical equipment. This is what our hard work and fundraising is meant for – Making a Difference! Let's continue to work together to do more in the future.


