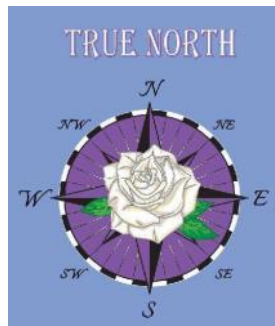


Ladies of the Household,
