We are still searching for a new secretary.

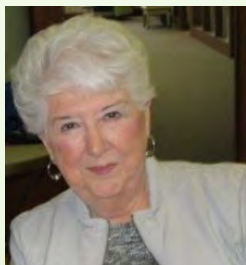
