



Legislation from the 102nd Supreme Session

Supreme Temple Bylaws Amendments with Previous Notice

Adopted: C-1. PART II, ARTICLE II MEMBERSHIP, SECTION 6. Dual Membership

Amend by substituting: A member may belong to multiple Subordinate Temples at the same time (Plural Membership). She shall have the privilege of making motions and voting in all of her Temples.

Adopted as amended: C-2. PART II, ARTICLE VII SUBORDINATE TEMPLE SESSIONS, SECTION 2. Ceremonials Amend by substituting a new SECTION 2: (a) Each Temple shall hold at least two (2) Ceremonials annually, one to be at the time of the Official Visit of the Supreme Queen. The Temple Officers shall exemplify the Amplified Opening, Initiation, and Closing at the time of the Official Visit of the Supreme Queen. (b) The Temple shall hold additional Ceremonials, if there are Candidates.

Failed: C-3. PART II, MEMBERSHIP, SECTION 1. (a) Eligibility

Amend by adding "or who is a personal friend of a Daughter of the Nile."

Adopted: C-4. PART II, ARTICLE VIII UNIFORMED UNITS, (b)

Amend by substituting a new (b). "All Units shall be covered by Unit Bylaws that shall receive final review and approval by the Temple Bylaws Committee, with follow-up notification by the Bylaws Committee to the Temple. In addition, the Units may adopt their own Standing Rules."

Adopted: C-5. PART I, ARTICLE I, SOVEREIGNTY AND ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE, SECTION 7. Ritualistic Properties and Philanthropy (a) Ritual and Secret Work

Amend by striking out "Under penalty of EXPLUSION from the Order," and inserting "Except for study purposes,"

Adopted: C-6. PART II, ARTICLE VII, SUBORDINATE TEMPLE SESSIONS, SECTION 1. Stated Sessions (a)

Amend by inserting "With the approval of the Supreme Queen, a Subordinate Temple may hold fewer than nine (9) Stated Sessions if catastrophic circumstances exist."
